To remove a Lamp Module: (Example shown in decking)

- 1. Using the Compressed Air Kit (*Part No:* PLACB) remove any sand or organic debris around the lamp.
- Turn the knob counter-clockwise until approximately one Inch of threads are visible.
- 3. Align the tool vertically over the Lamp Module, and press it down firmly- so it fits snug onto the lamp.
- 4. Twist the tool 1/4 turn (90°) counter-clockwise, and pull the tool straight up. NOTE: The tool utilizes a wedge fit, so more downward pressure may be required. Do not force or turn the tool more than 1/4 turn or the locking tabs may bend.
- 5. Clean the mounting surface of all debris. Eject the lamp from the tool by turning the knob clockwise.
- 6. Turn the knob counter-clockwise until approximately one Inch of threads are visible. Press a new Lamp Module into the tool firmly, with the socket side out.
- 7. Remove the protective tape on the Module, exposing the socket and anti-corrosive compound. NOTE: Do not wipe off. Inspect the plug and clean of any debris. Press the plug into the socket and insure the anticorrosive compound covers the boot.
- 8. Carefully feed the Wire Harness back into the base. Align the locking ears on the Lamp Module with the top of the base. Twist the tool 1/4 turn (90°) clock wise, locking it in place. NOTE: Do not use excessive force or rotate more than 1/4 turn (90°) or the locking tabs may bend.
- 9. Turn the knob clockwise while holding the tool from turning. The tool will release.
